 - Including verbal and written communication
- Subcommittees
 - Ad-hoc subcommittees are allowed (restricted to Taskforce members)
 - If committees include members of the public, they must be Brown Acted

Facilitation Strategy

- Taskforce process that is active, inclusive, and member-driven
- Leverage and build on existing work (other initiatives)
- Phased approach to subcommittee work



Roles & Responsibilities

RDA

- Facilitate conversations
- Provide structure and direction for Taskforce activities
- Guide planning process through completion of 7 plans
- Coordinate and liaise with other initiatives
- Support with BOS report outs
- Communicate consistent updates to Taskforce members

TASKFORCE

- Maintain consistent and active engagement
- Share institutional and experiential knowledge
- Collaboratively design the Care First system
- Engage in the entire process (Including work between meetings, subcommittees, surveys, etc.)

- **Phase 1:** Shared understanding of CFJL model and SIM framework to promote inclusive participation
- **Phase 2:** Robust system design based on identified intercepts
- **Phase 3:** Actionable plans and implementation timeline



Subcommittee Structure

PHASE 1

NOW – NOV '22

- Data
- Finance
- Education

PHASE 2

SEP '22 – MAR '23

- Intercept-based planning

PHASE 3

MAR '23 – APR '24

- Refinement of intercept planning
- Agency focused plan creation
- Program & policy prioritization
- County-wide roadmap



Proposed Initial Subcommittees

Data

- Identify the data required to understand population needs and impact measurement
- Coordinate across subcommittees to create unified data requests/reporting

Finance

- Examine budgets and funding mechanisms for existing models
- Develop budget for CFJL model implementation

Education

- Continue to identify information needs of Task Force members
- Advise on outside sources for potential programs and models



Subcommittees

- **Phase 1** subs are voluntary, continued membership on education committee
- **Phase 2 and 3** subs will be assigned
- **Phase 2 and 3** subs will have consistent structure
- Subs will be **convened by RDA**



Data Subcommittee

Objective

To identify meaningful data and coordinate data reporting

Guiding Questions

- What data do we need to understand needs of the population and measure impact?
- How can we coordinate across subcommittees to create unified data requests/reporting?



Finance Subcommittee

Objective

To establish budgetary models and guidelines

Guiding Questions

- What are the budgetary and funding mechanisms for existing models?
- How can we ensure fiscal sustainability for CFJL implementation?



Education Subcommittee

Objective

To establish a baseline of shared knowledge

Guiding Questions

- What terms/concepts are crucial for everyone to know?
- Who can share this knowledge?
